

INVITATION TO TENDER  
FOR **LARGE-SCALE FLOATING SOLAR PHOTOVOLTAIC PROJECT AT PANDAN  
RESERVOIR**

To all tenderers,

- 1 The Public Utilities Board (“the **Board**”) hereby invites interested companies (and applicants) (“**Tenderers**”) to participate in the abovementioned tender. This is a WTO-GPA/FTA covered tender.
- 2 The list of tender documents is enclosed and the Tenderer shall conform to the requirements given in the tender documents.
- 3 This is an Open tender and is one-off non-recurring contract for the supply of Goods & Services. The estimated commencement date for this contract is March 2025 or such other date as the Board may decide and the supply of Goods & Services is to be completed within 29 years.
- 4 Tenderers registered with **Building Construction Authority (BCA)** in the **ME03 (Solar PV System Integration) or ME05 (Electrical Engineering)** registration head of financial grade **L6** are invited to tender for this project. For Tenderers not registered with the required BCA workhead and financial grade, their Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) Contractor shall be registered with BCA in registration head **ME03** and financial grade **L6** OR registration head **ME05** and financial grade **L6**.
- 5 Tenderers or EPC Contractor who are not registered with BCA in the registration head and financial grade specified in paragraph 4 may still download the Invitation to Tender. However, they are advised to apply for registration with the relevant Government Registration Authority (GRA) at the earliest possible opportunity and enclose with their tenders a copy of the receipt for registration fee paid if their registration with the relevant GRA is still pending.
- 6 Tenderers are advised to adopt the National Wages Council’s (NWC) recommendations on wage increment for their workers and to factor such wage increases into their bid price.
- 7 A tender briefing will be conducted, and attendance is **non-compulsory**. The tender briefing will be held strictly in-person and will not be recorded.

- 8 Confidential Information will be made available to the Tenderers strictly via a Physical Data Room (PDR). The Confidential Information will include financial, geotechnical, and topographical data. Viewing of the Confidential Information in the PDR is **compulsory** for all Tenderers and shall be completed at least seven (7) days prior to the Closing Date and Time specified below. The details of the PDR will be sent via email upon successful receipt of the Confidentiality Deed.

- 9 Tender offers shall be submitted in accordance with the following mode(s) of submission not later than 1600 hours Singapore time on **Thursday, 26 September 2024** (“**Closing Date and Time**”). Any tender delivered after the Closing Date and Time from whatever cause arising will not be considered or accepted by the Board.

- 10 Tenders shall remain valid for **Two Hundred and Seventy (270) days** from the Closing Date and Time and no tenderer may withdraw his tender within that period (“**Validity Period**”). The period of 270 days may be extended by in accordance with Clause 7.2 of the Instructions to Tenderers.
- 11 Tender offer(s) must be submitted in English.
- 12 Tenderers who wish to seek clarifications on the tender or extension of the Closing Date and Time shall submit their request to Director, Catchment & Waterways Department, at the address stated in Clause 21.5 of the Instructions to Tenderers **at least seven (7) days** before the Closing Date and Time.
